


SAFETY POLICY

MEDICAL ROOM:

If you are feeling unwell or have any medical concerns, visit the medical room, equipped with both a nurse and emergency medical personnel. More information about the services offered in this room will be provided as we get closer to our Annual Meeting & Expo.

INCREASED HAND SANITIZER STATIONS:

Located in every meeting room and throughout the Expo Hall.



DEEP CLEANING OF MEETING ROOMS:

1) The Hyatt's air handling system brings in fresh air from outside. The air is then filtered to remove particles, dust, and allergens. In addition, there is a UV system in every air handler to kill any bacteria or virus prior to attendees entering.

2) Look for longer breaks between sessions, during which we provide deep cleaning for each of meeting rooms by wiping down chairs and filtering the air with electrostatic disinfectant sprayers.

CONTACTLESS REGISTRATION BADGE PICK UP:

Scan your QR code at one of our 24-hour badge access retrieval stations and avoid long lines.



3) The Expo Hall will be deep cleaned each night with a deep fogger to sanitize the air.



FLEXIBLE EATING HOURS IN THE EXPO HALL:

To help reduce long buffet lunch lines, this year we will have market stands located throughout the Expo Hall where you can access meals at your leisure, beginning one hour after the hall has opened and ending one hour before it closes.
